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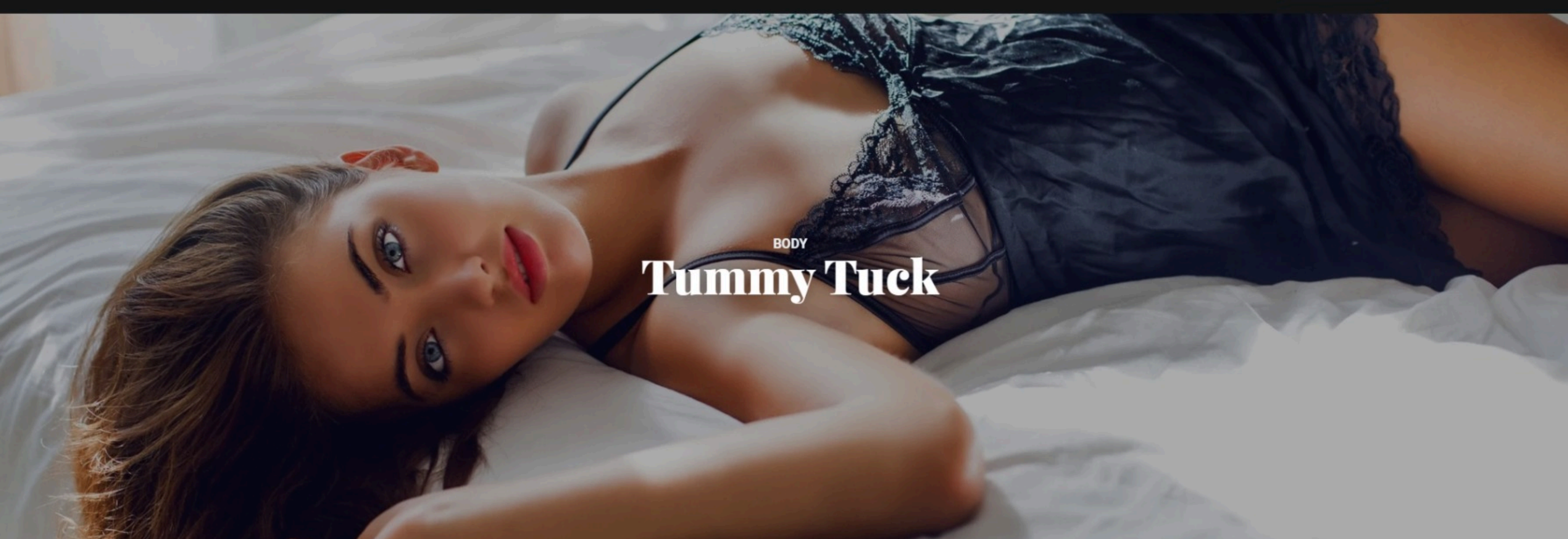
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What is a Tummy Tuck?



A tummy tuck, or abdominoplasty, is a surgical procedure designed to enhance the contour of your abdomen. It addresses issues such as excess skin, stubborn fat deposits, and weakened abdominal muscles. During the procedure, excess skin and fat are removed, and the underlying muscles are tightened to create a flatter, more toned appearance.

A tummy tuck can significantly improve the body's overall proportion and confidence. Ideal candidates for this procedure are individuals who have reached a stable weight and have difficulty eliminating stubborn abdominal fat through diet and exercise.

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How is a Tummy Tuck performed?

A tummy tuck, or abdominoplasty, is a cosmetic procedure to remove excess skin and fat from the abdomen and tighten the abdominal muscles. During the operation, the surgeon makes a horizontal incision just above the pubic area. Then, the skin and fat are separated from the abdominal muscles, which are tightened and sutured to create a firmer abdomen. The remaining skin is stretched down, and the excess is trimmed away. Finally, the incision is closed with sutures, and a temporary drain may be placed to remove any accumulated fluid.

Who is a candidate for this surgery?

A candidate for a tummy tuck is someone in good health who has excess skin, fat, or weakened abdominal muscles that don't respond to diet and exercise. Ideal candidates include:

- Excess fat
- Tummy bulge
- Loose or sagging skin
- Post-pregnancy abdominal changes
- Stretched or weakened abdominal muscles

How long is the surgery?

A tummy tuck surgery typically takes about 2 to 5 hours, depending on the extent of the procedure.

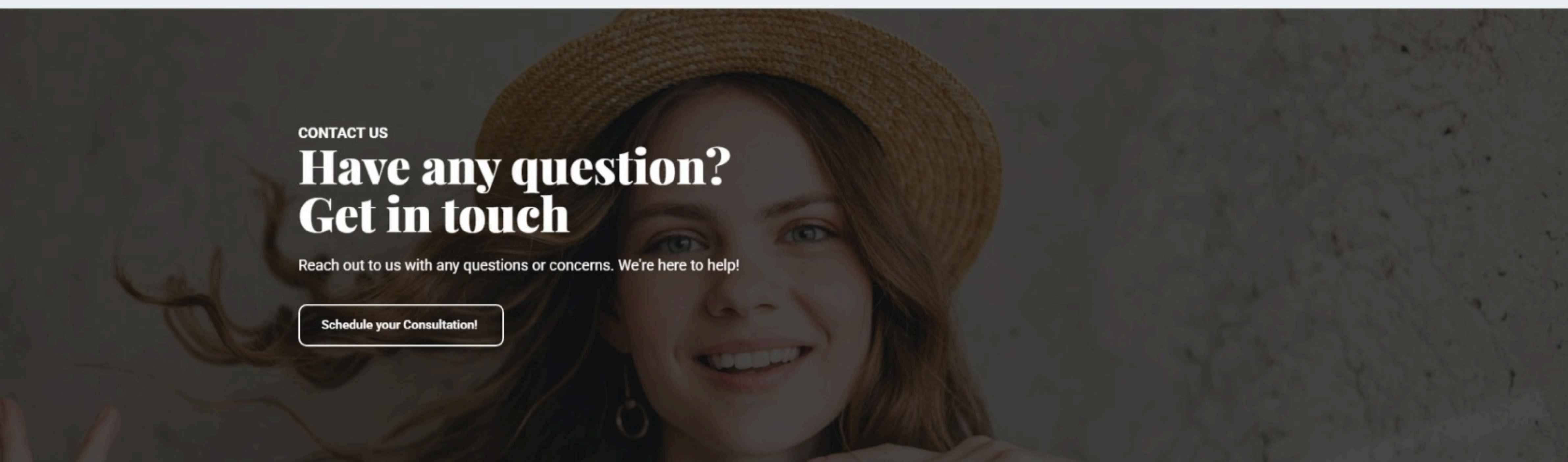

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What is a Brazilian Butt Lift?



A Brazilian Butt Lift (BBL) is a cosmetic procedure designed to enhance the size and shape of the buttocks using the patient's own fat. This technique involves removing fat from areas like the abdomen, thighs, or flanks through liposuction and then purifying and reinjecting it into the buttocks.

The goal is to create a fuller, more rounded appearance while also contouring the areas where the fat was removed, resulting in a more balanced and aesthetically pleasing silhouette.

STEP 2: RECEIVE YOUR QUOTE

After we receive your Pre-Consultation Form and photos, you will be provided with a detailed, all-inclusive plastic surgery package quote. A doctor (not a nurse) will visit you at your hotel five days a week to monitor your progress and assist with any needs during your stay. Usually, two post-surgical appointments are necessary to ensure proper healing. During the final consultation, your surgeon will check the incisions, remove stitches if needed, and give the go-ahead for you to return home.

STEP 9: RETURN TO YOUR COUNTRY
